WELCOME

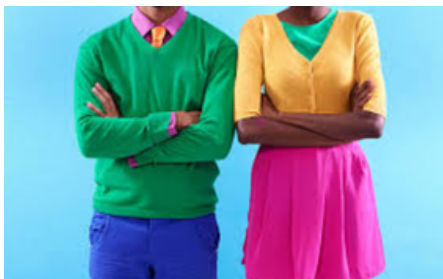

This week we listened to 'The Nutcracker'. Tchaikovsky's magical ballet is based on The Nutcracker and Mouse King a fairy story by the German writer E.T.A. Hoffman. Tchaikovsky was born in Votkinsk, Russia, in 1840 and began piano lessons when he was just five years old. Despite of a precocious talent his first job was as a civil servant; a role he eventually left to study music at the St. Petersburg Conservatory aged 22.
